Buying tickets for outdoor performances, music festivals or sports events?

Ticket fraud is big business. Don't be ripped-off!

Getting hold of tickets from official sources can be very difficult. Some events sell out in minutes of the box office opening, tickets sales are limited to 'members only' or ticket numbers are limited. This all makes it tempting to buy from individuals or unofficial sellers if you really want to be at a particular festival or see that big game live. Here are a few 'top tips' from www.getsafeonline.org on buying tickets safely:

- 1 buy tickets only from the venue box office, sports club, promoter, official agent or reputable fan ticket exchange sites
- 2 never pay individuals or businesses by bank transfer, however desperate you are to get your tickets
- 3 paying by credit card offers greater protection than other payment methods
- 4 double check all details of your ticket purchase before confirming payment
- 5 when buying online DO NOT reply or 'click' on links in emails and social media posts from sellers you don't recognise, and don't open attachments
- 6 before entering credit card details on a website screen, ensure that the payment page is genuine and secure, and log out when you have finished your transaction
- 7 check seller's privacy and returns policy read the Terms & Conditions
- 8 keep your receipts until after the event
- 9 check credit card statements show the correct amount and look for any unauthorised transactions
- 10 keep your internet security up to date and always have it switched-on.

Crimes in April & May

Five residential properties were burgled and there were 12 reports of non-residential break-ins (7 beach huts and 5 garages).

No motor vehicles were stolen but the police had 5 reports of thefts from motor vehicles. Always lock your car even when it is parked on your drive. Never leave valuables on display on a seat or on the floor. There were 11 reports of other thefts. Do not leave valuables unattended.
